All hunts are free ranging fair chase.

**CANCELLATIONS**

After successfully drawing a license in the 10% outfitter draw pool utilizing H&A Outfitter's, Inc. New Mexico registered outfitter number, your total hunt payment and state license is non-refundable.

**INCLUDED IN HUNT COST**

H&A Outfitters, Inc. semi-guided elk, deer and pronghorn hunts include a professional guide – 1 guide for 2 - 4 hunters for 2 or 4 days, whatever is agreed upon between outfitter and clients. During your semi-guided hunt days only, your guide will scout proven ground 1 day prior to hunt date, guide for 2 or 4 days, and assist in field care and packing. Clients can continue hunting on their own for the duration of their license.

**NOT INCLUDED IN HUNT COST**

Landowner permits are your option and your expense. New Mexico State license fees, State Gross Receipt Tax, camps, supplies, meals, transportation (unless other arrangements have been made between outfitter and clients), taxidermy, meat processing, shipping of horns or meat, airport pickup.
